The Property is transferred "AS IS" and "WHERE IS" and "WITH ALL FAULTS", and the Town makes no warranties of any kind, express or implied, regarding the Property, its quality and/or condition, or otherwise, and all warranties, including but not limited to warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, are expressly disclaimed.
