

ORDINANCE 2018-11

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF WHITESTOWN, INDIANA CONCERNING
REDISTRICTING OF TOWN COUNCIL DISTRICTS**

WHEREAS, the Town of Whitestown, Indiana ("Town") is divided into five (5) districts for the purpose of electing Town Council members ("Council District(s)"); and

WHEREAS, the Town is and has been the fastest growing community in the State of Indiana, experiencing significant growth in population since the 2010 federal decennial census; and

WHEREAS, due to the increases in population in various areas of the Town, the Town requested and engaged the U.S. Census Bureau to perform a special census of the Town in 2016; and

WHEREAS, according to the special census completed by U.S. Census Bureau, the official population of the Town increased from 2,867 in 2010 to 7,814 as of November 18, 2016; and

WHEREAS, based on the new census, the population deviation for the current Town Council Districts exceeds thirty-four percent; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council now desires to amend and redistrict the Town Council Districts in accordance with Indiana law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Whitestown, Boone County, Indiana as follows:

Section 1: The above recitals are incorporated herein by this reference as though fully set forth herein below.

Section 2: The five (5) Council Districts for the Town of Whitestown are hereby amended, and the Council Districts are hereby restated and established, as set forth in the map attached hereto as Exhibit A, which map is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3: This Ordinance and the new Council Districts established hereunder take effect immediately upon the adoption of this Ordinance as follows: Current Town Council members shall continue to hold office until the term for which the Town Council member was elected has expired under state law, the new Council Districts established under this Ordinance shall constitute a current member's Council District for purposes of determining the district from which he/she was elected and/or whether a member continues to be a resident of his/her Council District, and the current Town Council member represents the Council District established under this Ordinance in which the member's legal residence is located.

Section 4: The Town Clerk-Treasurer and/or Town Attorney shall forward a signed copy of this Ordinance to the Boone County Circuit Court Clerk, along with a copy of Exhibit A, not later than thirty (30) days after its adoption.

Section 5: This Ordinance, with its attachment, shall be put on file with the Town Clerk-Treasurer for public inspection.

Section 6: All prior ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed and superseded to the extent in conflict herewith.






