A RESOLUTION CONCERNING AN UPDATED POLICY
AS TO ALCOHOL ON TOWN PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Town of Whitestown, Indiana (“Town” or “Whitestown”) has previously adopted a policy, pursuant to Resolution No. 2014-25, concerning alcohol on property and at certain facilities owned by the Town; and

WHEREAS, as the Town continues to grow, add facilities and property, and provide more opportunities for its residents and businesses, the Town is adding more diverse events throughout the Town and its properties; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to update the written policy concerning the presence of alcohol on all Town property and/or facilities, including the community and event center, park property, and any other facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Whitestown, Indiana, as follows:

Section 1. No alcohol shall be permitted on any property or in any facilities owned by the Town except as specifically provided in Section 2 hereof. The Town reserves the right to remove anyone consuming alcohol on property or in facilities owned by the Town from that property and/or facility and to restrict that person from using Town property in the future.

Section 2. Alcohol may only be permitted to be brought onto and consumed at or on any Town property or facility only (a) with the express written permission of the Town Council, or (b) during a Town-sponsored event with the written approval of either the Town Manager or Parks Director.

Section 3. The Town Manager shall adopt procedures and policies, establish rules, and take other measures reasonably necessary to effectuate this Resolution. Such policies shall include requiring all applicable permits and maintaining appropriate levels of insurance.

Section 4. Nothing herein shall limit the right of the Town Council to amend the alcohol policy or the Town Manager’s procedures and/or measures to effectuate this Resolution. The terms, paragraphs, sentences, and words of this Resolution are separable, and if a court or other authority of competent jurisdiction hereof declares any portion unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable for any reason, such declaration shall not affect the remaining portions. This Resolution supersedes Resolution No. 2014-25.




