A RESOLUTION COMMENDING GOVERNOR ERIC HOLCOMB'S  
2019 INFRASTRUCTURE TRAIL AGENDA

WHEREAS, Indiana has approximately 36,000 total miles of trails, including local, state, federal, and nonprofit trails that are open to the public; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Natural Resources has a goal to provide a trail within five (5) miles of every Hoosier by 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Whitestown, Indiana actively promotes and encourages the construction and expansion of public trails within and around the Whitestown community; and

WHEREAS, Whitestown has a growing public trail system that is ripe for connection with trails in nearby communities and unincorporated areas; and

WHEREAS, Governor Eric Holcomb has announced the administration's 2019 Next Level Connections infrastructure agenda, which includes \$90 million to link communities through more hiking, biking, and riding trails; and

WHEREAS, the majority of trail funding in the 2019 Next Level Connections program will be used to create a grant program for local and regional trails, with emphasis on connections between cities, towns, and counties and connections between existing trails, shovel ready projects, and those that are part of a regional plan or quality of place initiative; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council fully supports the expansion of the trail systems in the State, including regional connectivity within Boone County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Whitestown, Indiana, on behalf of the citizens of Whitestown, commends Governor Eric Holcomb's 2019 Next Level Connections infrastructure initiatives with respect to hiking, biking, and riding trails.
