A RESOLUTION URGING THE INDIANA GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO ADOPT  
HOUSE BILL 1118 REGARDING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE PERMITS  
AND REDEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, the Town of Whitestown is the fastest growing community in the State of Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Census Bureau has estimated that Whitestown's population has already more than doubled since the 2010 Census; and

WHEREAS, the Town has experienced significant economic development over the past decade; and


WHEREAS, at the same time, limits on alcoholic beverage permits tied to outdated Census data have inhibited the Town's ability to attract quality retail investments and restaurants that are desired by the Whitestown community; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 1118 would permit developers in Whitestown and other growing communities adjacent to Indianapolis to obtain alcoholic beverage permits as a part of certain economic development projects.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Whitestown Town Council hereby urges the Indiana General Assembly to adopt House Bill 1118 to authorize the issuance of additional alcoholic beverage permits in certain counties adjacent to Indianapolis as a part of certain economic development projects.


