**A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE INDIANA GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR ASSISTING  
IN THE POSITIVE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF WHITESTOWN  
THROUGH THE CREATION OF CONTROLLED ALCOHOL BEVERAGE PERMITS**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Whitestown is the fastest growing community in the State of Indiana; and

**WHEREAS**, although the U.S. Census Bureau has estimated that Whitestown's population has more than doubled since the 2010 Census alone, restrictions on alcohol beverage permits can impede Whitestown's ability to attract desired economic development investments and amenities consistent with Whitestown's growth; and

**WHEREAS**, opportunities for quality economic development are available through the controlled distribution of alcohol beverage permits for that purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the 119<sup>th</sup> Indiana General Assembly (2016) has now adopted legislation, designated as House Enrolled Act 1386, that authorizes the issuance of limited special alcoholic beverage permits in certain economic development areas within Whitestown; and

**WHEREAS**, House Enrolled Act 1386 will allow Whitestown to attract and also control retail investments and restaurants that are desired by Whitestown and the surrounding community, and will further the goals of quality economic development.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town Council of the Town of Whitestown, Indiana, that the Town Council, on the behalf of Whitestown property owners, residents, and businesses, hereby commends the 119<sup>th</sup> Indiana General Assembly for its action in assisting Whitestown in providing for quality economic development investment and amenities through the enactment of House Enrolled Act 1386.


