## General Updates

Whitestown Metropolitan Police Department has been working diligently to accomplish the following:

- The police department continues to be closed:
  - The police department is closed to visitors and business is being conducted by appointment only.
  - Officers are continuing to practice good safety precautions and wear their masks as they respond to calls. In addition, officers are responding to calls over the phone when possible.
- Peer Support program
  - Officer Kirsten Gibbons created and implemented a Peer Support program for WMPD officers. This program provides an officer resources to seek confidential assistance tailored to the specific need for officers, and is a proactive approach to addressing Officer Mental Wellness.
- Fleet Services
  - Over the course of the upcoming months, fleet services personnel will be installing Axon in-car camera systems in the entire fleet.
- New Equipment
  - Officers have received their active shooter ballistic vests along with their corresponding helmets.

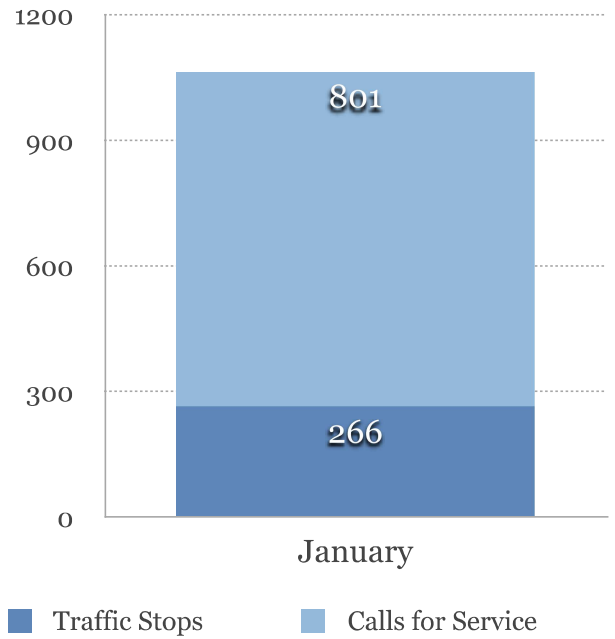
# Monthly Statistics

## Investigations Division

## Training Division

- Canine handlers put in 39 hours of training with their furry partners.
- Whitestown Metropolitan Police Department has implemented a monthly physical tactics regiment.
  - Physical tactics instructors are currently teaching physical tactics once a month. Each month instructors go over different use of force and or physical tactics. In addition, instructors are providing open gyms opportunities for officers to seek additional physical tactics training.
