UPDATE: New Police Headquarters Building

1. Building update; The roofing component is complete, electrical ruff-in is underway, as is HVAC systems. The sally-port overhead doors and automated openers have been installed. Exterior windows and doors are scheduled for delivery on site with installation to begin the week of 16th. A small area of roofing has come loose as well as some of the white Tyvek wrapping and one of the silver insulation boards from the wind. Those items have been slated for repair by the contractor. A question was raised by a commercial architect in the area regarding the application of a dual-vapor barrier behind the brick exterior. The concern for the possibility of future mold growth between the vapor barriers over time. This concern was addressed with the builder, Graber Post Buildings and I have attached for you a copy of the letter furnished to us by D. B. Tarr & Co. addressing this matter. (Attachment) Building construction remains on schedule and on budget.

UPDATE: CAC Funding request for 2020

1. The Boone County Prosecutor and the Director of the CAC have request funding assistance from all BC LEA as the CAC has lost one of their funding grants that will deeply affect the CAC's operation

moving forward. The Police Commission took up this matter at their monthly meeting on December 3, 2019. During that meeting the commission advanced to the Town Council a proposal of \$10,000 in funding assistances for the CAC with unanimous “due pass” recommendation. This funding will be taken from the following WMPD budget lines;
