UPDATE: New Police Headquarters Building

1. Site work continues. The elevator shaft base has been installed. Framing is underway, first floor framing is complete, and the 2nd floor is well underway. Roof trusses are due on site the week of 10/7. Side boring for the water line is underway and drainage installation has begun. The building schedule remains on track for July 1, 2020.

UPDATE: Death Investigation

On Friday, September 27, 2019 at approx. 8:50pm WMPD was dispatched to the Homewood Suites off Perry Worth Road regarding an unconscious male subject. Upon arrival officers found a 59-year-old white male deceased on the floor in his room. Preliminary investigation showed that the subject failed to check out of his room at 11 a.m., A member of the Management staff entered the room and found the subject, then called 911. This case remains under investigation.

UPDATE: Police Vehicle Crash

1. On Monday September 30, 2019 at approximately 12:45 p.m., PSO Chris Fischer was involved in a Property Damage crash on Whitestown Parkway at Center Drive. PSO Fischer witnessed a moving violation, activated his emergency equipment (lights) paused, then attempted to cross over the intersection when a vehicle travelling east did not see PSO Fischer due to a large box truck in the turn lane, struck Fischer's marked WMPD vehicle on the right front corner. Both vehicles sustained moderate frontend damage and had to be towed. No injuries were reported.
