b. BZA21-003-VA Outdoor Specialist Variance

- i. Dan Reynolds Owner of Outdoor Specialist recently purchased Brush Turk Care. Requesting to build a storage building for equipment to make the area look better as well as for safety of equipment.
- ii. Brittany Garriott Staff Report Variances are approved based on the finding of facts:

- 1. The variances will not be injurious to the public health, safety, morals, and general welfare of the community because: The existing use has been permitted to operate since 2017 and the use of the property is not changing.
- 2. The use or value of the area adjacent to the property included in the variances will not be affected in a substantially adverse manner because: Outdoor storage of vehicles and materials may be unsightly. The request to construct an accessory structure will allow vehicles and other storage to be contained indoors.
- 3. The strict application of the terms of the Ordinance will continue the unusual and unnecessary hardship as applied to the property for which the variances are sought because: The maximum permitted area of a structure is 1,000 square feet which is relatively small for commercial and agricultural structures.
