**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITESTOWN, INDIANA  
FOR THE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL PROPERTY TO THE  
INDIANA LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING BOARD**

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council for the Town of Whitestown, Indiana (respectively, "Town Council" and "Town") desires to transfer to the Indiana Law Enforcement Training Board ("ILETB"), for use by the ILETB at the Indiana Law Enforcement Academy ("ILEA"), a certain 2012 Chevrolet Tahoe PPV (White) with VIN # 1GNLC2E05CR253136 and a certain 2012 Chevrolet Tahoe PPV (White) with VIN #1GNLCE05CR243072, which is no longer needed by the Whitestown Police Department ("Property"); and

**WHEREAS**, ILETB desires to accept the transfer of the Property; and


**WHEREAS**, Indiana Code § 5-22-22-10 allows the Town to transfer the Property to ILETB for terms and conditions agreed upon by the governmental bodies, as evidenced by the adoption of substantially identical resolutions by each entity.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town Council of the Town of Whitestown, Indiana, as follows:

1. The transfer of the Property to ILETB in accordance with Indiana Code § 5-22-22-10 is hereby approved in exchange for 550 (225 per vehicle) training hours credit for use by the Whitestown Metropolitan Police Department at the ILEA and other good and valuable consideration, the sufficiency of which is acknowledged by the Town. The Town Council President and/or Whitestown Police Chief is/are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents and take such actions as may be necessary to complete such transfer. The Property is transferred "AS IS" and "WHERE IS" and "WITH ALL FAULTS", and the Town makes no warranties of any kind, express or implied, regarding the Property, its quality and/or condition, or otherwise, and all warranties, including but not limited to warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, are expressly disclaimed.
