

ORDINANCE 2020-31

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF WHITESTOWN, INDIANA, CLOSING TOWN COURT BANK ACCOUNT AND
TRANSFERRING FUNDS TO THE RAINY DAY FUND**

WHEREAS, the Town of Whitestown, Indiana ("Town") has dissolved its Town Court; and

WHEREAS, the Town maintained a maintained a bank account at Huntington Bank for the purpose of conducting Town Court business (the "Court Bank Account" and "Court Fund"); and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town been advised that as of the date of this Ordinance, the Town has an unused and unencumbered balance in the Court Bank Account/Court Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Town has previously established a Rainy Day Fund under I.C. § 36-1-8-5.1; and

WHEREAS, I.C. §§ 36-1-8-5 & 5.1 provide that the Council may order such unencumbered balance to be transferred to the Rainy Day Fund.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Town Council of the Town of Whitestown, Indiana, as follows:

Section 1. That the entire balance in the Court Bank Account/Court Fund, all of which is unused and unencumbered, be transferred to the Rainy Day Fund established under I.C. § 36-1-8-5.1. The Clerk Treasurer shall report the transfer to the Department of Local Government Finance as may be required by applicable law.

Section 2. That upon completion of the transfer of the funds in the Court Bank Account/Court Fund to the Rainy Day Fund that the Court Bank Account/Court Fund shall be, and hereby is, closed and terminated.

Adopted by the Town Council of the Town of Whitestown, Indiana, on this 16th day of November, 2020, by a vote of 5 in favor and 0 against.
