General Updates

Whitestown Metropolitan Police Department has been working diligently to accomplish the following:

- Hiring Process
 - The police department is in their final stages of the hiring process. In January, the Criminal Investigations Unit finished their background investigation on applicants. In addition, 5 applicants continued on to their medical and psychological backgrounds with PERF.
- Monthly Training
 - All officers completed online training. This training covered individuals in Medical Distress within police custody. The training covered a variety of areas including but not limited to, recognizing when individuals are in medical distress and basic medical care for individuals in medical distress.
 - Officer Gipson attended grant writing school. This training will be useful to seek alternative funding sources.
 - Sgt. (Paramedic) Klinger attended his annual paramedic refresher course. This course was a 60 hour course that counted towards his continuing education for his certification. Sgt. Klinger is an additional resource used on city medical calls to give community members fast quality care prior to Fire's primary care.

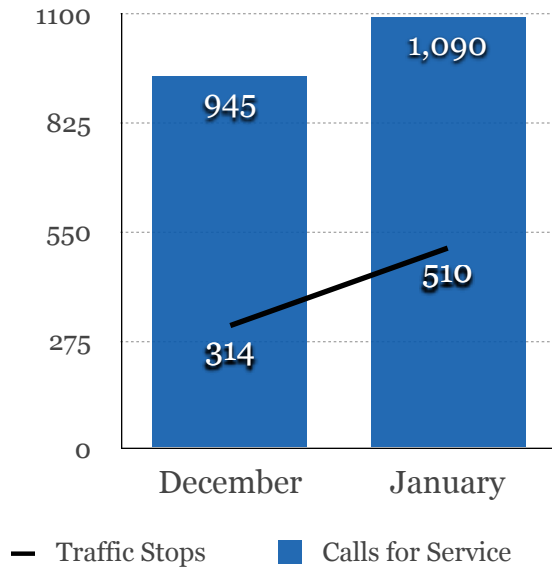
