Fire Training:

Total Fire Training Hours: 1100

In the month of June, we have logged 1100 hours of training. We are fortunate enough to have two houses, that are set to be demolished, given to us for training. Inside these houses all crews completed MAYDAY training. This training is needed to ensure we can save one of our own in the event we have an emergency on the fire ground. Completing this training inside of a house makes it as realistic as possible and as challenging as it would be in real life. After completing this training, the crews have been given permission to do any training they want with these homes. Crews have spent the last 4 shifts of the month training at this location and have plans to continue until the houses are demolished.

In the Northside Fire Academy our recruit is coming in to his own. He is a top finisher in the class. His performance has been nothing short of amazing. He has successfully passed his class final, Vehicle Rescuer Operations State test, and Firefighter 1 and 2 state tests. The class now has 3 weeks left and will be focused on putting together all the skills learned throughout this academy. The next 2 weeks will be live fire scenarios to help solidify the skills needed to be successful.

Graduation is set for July 19th at 1800 hours. The event will be held in the auditorium of Westfield High School located at 18250 N Union St. Westfield IN 46074.






Run difference from 2023 / 270 Runs, 35% Increase






EMS Incident Map








Fire Incident Map







Vehicle Collision Incident Map








Public Assist Incident Map
