Park/Town Facilities Maintenance Updates

- All recycled benches and trash cans are placed throughout our park properties.
- Jackson run playground installed. Amenities and dog waste stations added.
- Lots of trimming along the trail has been done. Looking into quotes for Sickle Bar trimmer to keep it clean and cut back much easier. This will also help with ditch cutting at Jackson run and around the pond at Anson, along with other areas.
- Continued maintenance of trailhead pollinator garden. Still doing very well and many compliments have been made.
- Looking into solutions for splash pad slick surface. Multiple complaints of kids falling. Although this is mostly due to not running and no water shoes, which the rules sign clearly states. Researching and will be gathering quotes for repainting or resurfacing the play area.

Monthly Report-July 2024

- Independence Day event was a success. Make note of the larger generator needed for the stage power. 45kW minimum.
- Replaced chemical feed pump hose to fix lack of chlorine delivery to splash pad. This was why it went into failsafe alarm over the weekend and was not running for that Sunday.
- Continued helping with facility maintenance requests while Logan was on paternity leave. Mainly fire station projects. (Compressor, photocell, washers, etc.)
- Removed damaged playground piece from Jackson run. CRG is coming to replace that piece as well as a few border pieces that are cracked.
- Reached out to BPD about a few issues that need fixed in the last section of Prairie chase/Jackson run. They were quick to acknowledge and should have them fixed soon.
- Replaced lock on black trailer side door, as it broke and would not lock.
- Replaced outlet on shelter C at Main Street Park for the third time. Used a different plug this time to see if maybe we got a bad plug the last two times. If this one doesn't last long, we will have to investigate a potential power issue causing them to go bad so fast.
