## **Fire Training:**

1500 total training hours were logged this month.

Crews completed Extrication Training focusing on vehicle stabilization. Each crew completed one of two scenarios involving passenger vehicles in a simulated accident. Each scenario required crews to think on their feet and develop tactics based on past experiences. This exercise was great for the Officers to build their command-and-control techniques and build crew integrity. Crews were able to put hands on tools and equipment not frequently used. After each scenario was completed, the crews were given free range to practice different techniques on the vehicles. Crews debriefed each scenario and talked about tactical changes for the future.

The Battalion Chief Task Book draft has been given to the Battalions for review. I have been working closely with Operations Chief Owens on this and hope to have the final draft completed for approval by the end of October.

The Lateral Firefighter Syllabus is completed and added to the department calendar. The start date for this class is the 7<sup>th</sup> of October and will conclude on November 1st. Westfield Fire Department has two laterals they are adding to the class and will be sharing the responsibilities of training. This class will be four weeks long. Three weeks will be fire training and one week of EMS.






## Fire Monthly




## Fire Year To Date





### YTD Station




## Monthly Call Type







## EMS Incident Map



## Fire Incident Map


