#### **Determination of Basis for Special Purchase:**

This special purchase was made pursuant to I.C. 5-22-10-5 because there exists a unique opportunity to obtain the Goods at a substantial savings to the Town.

Using MES as our vendor to purchase all our personal protective equipment needs from one entity affords us an approximate 28% savings per fire helmet, and approximately 30% savings for each pair of gloves, which also uses the State of Indiana Bid 385-24-76821.

This special purchase was made pursuant to I.C. 5-22-10-8 because the compatibility of equipment, accessories, or replacement parts is a substantial consideration in the purchase and the Contractor is the only source that meets the Town's reasonable requirements.

The Whitestown Fire Department currently maintains the use of TecGen Fire Gear, Fire Dex Structural Firefight Boots, Fire Dex Leather Firefighting Gloves, Bullard Helmets, Captain Jim hoods, and HexArmor Extrication Gloves. MES is the source to obtain all the department's

personal protective equipment at our current specifications which allow us to maintain continuity of equipment utilized in environments that are immediately dangerous to life and health.

Municipal Emergency Services (MES) has been a responsive vendor that meets the needs of all our current personal protective equipment specifications and allows us to utilize a single vendor. MES having current bids for the State of Indiana allows for significant savings in applicable equipment.
