

ORDINANCE NO. 2025 - 14

**ORDINANCE OF THE WHITESTOWN TOWN COUNCIL ESTABLISHING
STORMWATER & TRANSPORTATION STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS &
DETAILS**

WHEREAS, the Town of Whitestown, Indiana (the "Town"), currently maintains and utilizes applicable standards for stormwater facility construction, as set forth in more detail within the most recent version of the Town's Stormwater Ordinance, the Town's Stormwater Management Ordinance, and the Boone County Stormwater Technical Standards Manual; and

WHEREAS, the Town also currently maintains and utilizes applicable standards for asphalt paving throughout Town limits on public and private roadways ("Transportation Standards"); and

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate third parties constructing stormwater facilities for connection to the various systems and/or dedications within the Town utility service areas, and to ensure that new and continued development within the Town follows an integrated and stormwater sewer system, the Town desires to ensure that all new and extended stormwater facilities conform to the Town's Master Plan(s) in sizing and general location ("Stormwater Standards"); and

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate asphalt paving standards throughout the jurisdiction of the Town, the town desires to ensure that all new pavement and driveways constructed within the Town limits meet certain Transportation Standards that conform to the Town's Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town has reviewed both the existing Stormwater and Transportation Standards and has determined that updates are necessary to reflect current and anticipated development patterns and growth of the Town and to reflect compliance with new state, federal and local laws, regulations, construction techniques, and technology advancements in order to ensure the operation of safe, reliable, and efficient stormwater facility construction and asphalt paving techniques; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that it is in the best interests of the Town to update its Stormwater and Transportation Standards as reflected in the attached Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE WHITESTOWN TOWN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

1. The foregoing Recitals are incorporated herein by this reference.
2. The Whitestown Town Council hereby adopts its Stormwater and Transportation Standard Specifications & Details as it pertains to the construction of stormwater facilities and asphalt paving as set forth in the attached Exhibit A.
3. The Town is instructed to maintain publicly accessible copies of the Stormwater and Transportation Standards.
4. That the Transportation Standards adopted by this Ordinance supersede any other prior Ordinance, Resolution, or Town document reflecting the same.
5. That the Stormwater Standards adopted by this Ordinance do not supersede or replace the latest versions of the Whitestown Stormwater Management Ordinance, the Town of Whitestown Stormwater Ordinance, and/or the Boone County Stormwater Technical Standards Manual. The Stormwater Standards adopted by this Ordinance shall be considered additional requirements to the already approved and adopted ordinances and shall be applicable to projects and facilities located within the Town of Whitestown, only, and shall apply pursuant to the terms listed herein and within attached Exhibit A.
6. Pursuant to IC 36-4-2-9, the Town Council designates its Utility Manager, in his/her sole and exclusive discretion, to determine the design, materials, and specifications for circumstances not covered or detailed within the attached, Exhibit A. Nothing within this Ordinance shall be construed to supersede applicable state or federal law, including but not limited to any regulations or rules promulgated by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (“IDEM”) or the Indiana Department of Transportation (“INDOT”) as may be applicable from time to time.
7. **Severability.** The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any part is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable, that determination will not affect the validity of the remaining parts. The court shall, to the extent permitted by law, substitute a valid and enforceable provision that most closely reflects the intent of the original.

8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication as required by Indiana law.
