Fire Training:
Total Hours – 2191
For the month of June 2,191 hours of training were logged by crews. This included crews helping with the 5 days of live fire with the North Side Fire Academy but does not reflect any recruit hours.
The recruits have completed 20-weeks in the North Side Fire Academy with members starting shift on 6/30. The recruits have completed over 3,600 total hours of training with over 120 hours of live fire training.
Each new member has completed state level training and are now certified in Hazmat Awareness and Operations, Firefighter I and II, Technical rescue awareness, Vehicle rescue operations and National Incident Managment Systems 100, 200, 700b and 800.







Annual Narcan Usage




EMS Incident Map








Fire Incident Map








Vehicle Collision Incident Map
